### **Looking for a Catholic School?**

School Choice enrollment will be open for **Most Precious Blood School** starting February 1<sup>st</sup>. Your family may qualify for a voucher that covers all tuition and our fees at Most Precious Blood Catholic School. If you qualify this year you will not need to meet the income limits in the future-you will only verify residency each year. <https://dpi.wi.gov/parental-education-options/choice-programs/student-applications>

Income eligibility is listed on the dpi website.

You will need to verify income by supplying a copy of your 2020 tax form or as part of the application process using the DOR option. You will also need to provide the school with residency documentation (W-2 form, Utility bill-gas, water, electric-with your address and the service address.
