Ushers – if you're at Mass, and want to usher, we thank you.

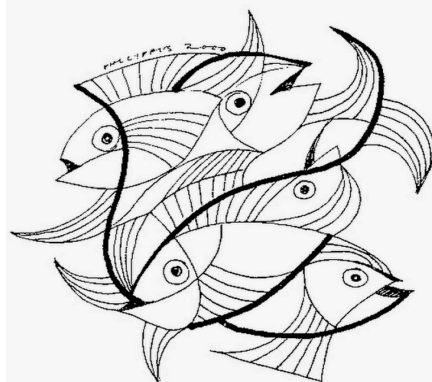
Servers – let us know if you would like to serve.
