Excerpts from Page 161 & 164, Book IV, Sponsors for Baptism and Confirmation.

## Chapter IV –Sponsors

**Can. 872** In so far as possible, a person being baptized is to be given a sponsor who is to assist an adult in Christian initiation, or, together with the parents, to present an infant at the Baptism, and who will help the baptized to lead a Christian life in harmony with Baptism, and to fulfill faithfully the obligations connected with it.

**Can. 873** Only one male or one female sponsor or one of each sex is to be employed.

**Can. 874 1. To be admitted to the role of Sponsor, a person must:**

- a. be designated by the one to be baptized, by the parents or the one who takes their place or, in their absence, by the pastor or minister and is to have the qualifications and intention of performing this role.
- b. have completed the sixteenth year, unless a different age has been established by the diocesan bishop or it seems to the pastor or minister that an exception is to be made for a just cause.
- c. be a Catholic who has been confirmed and had already received the sacrament of the Most Holy Eucharist and leads a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken;
- d. not be bound by any canonical penalty legitimately imposed or declared;
- e. not be the father or mother of the one to be baptized;

2. A baptized person who belongs to a non-Catholic ecclesial community may not be admitted except as a witness to baptism and together with a Catholic sponsor.

**Can. 892** As far as possible a sponsor for one to be confirmed should be present; it is for the sponsor to see that the confirmed person acts as a true witness to Christ and faithfully fulfills the obligations connected with this sacrament.

- Can. 893**
1. To perform the role of sponsor, it is necessary that a person fulfill the conditions mentioned in Can. 874
  2. It is desirable that the one who undertook the role of sponsor at baptism be sponsor for confirmation.
