From the Pastor:

My Dear Parish Family:

Even the secular world recognizes the importance of mothers and fathers with a special day for them to be thanked and honored. Therefore, we say thank you to all our fathers, grandfathers, godfathers and all those who have been a father figure in our lives. We are praying for all our dear fathers, both living and deceased, not only this weekend, but always. On a more mundane and certainly more earthly note, we are still involved in this year's Cardinal's Appeal. 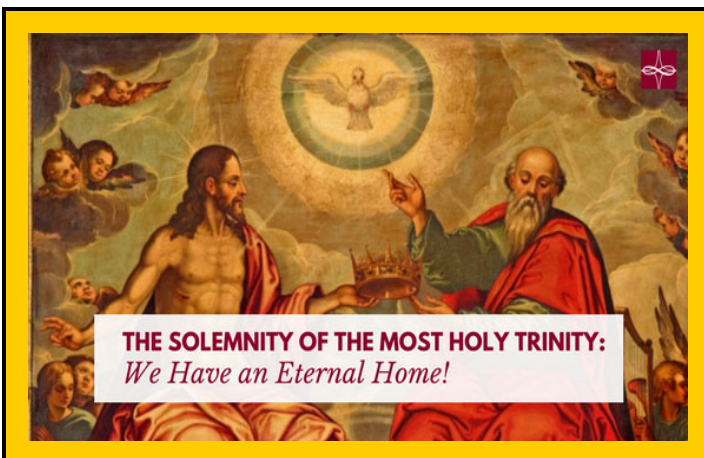

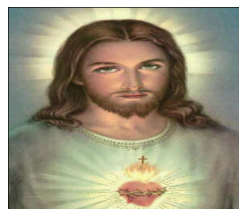
