The Sacrament of Marriage: Please call the Rectory at least six (6) months prior to date of Marriage.

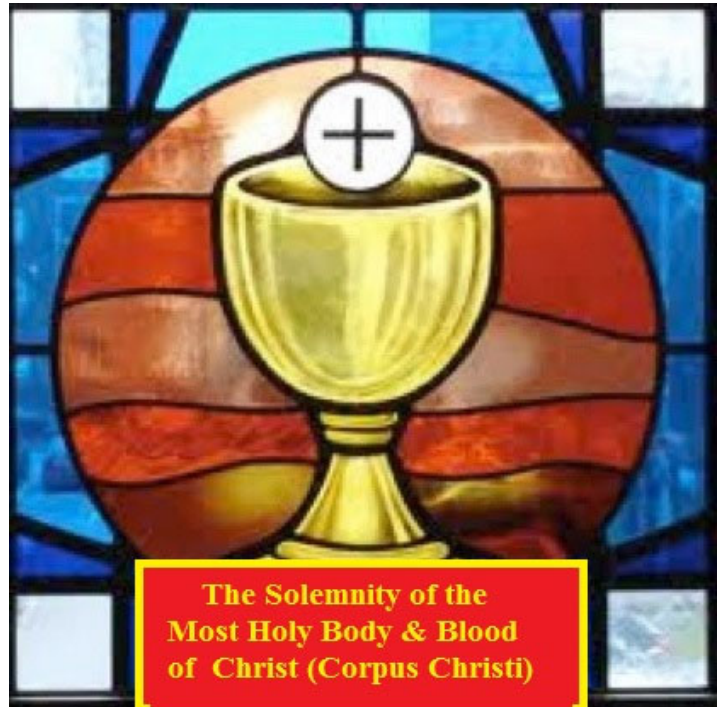
The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick: Please inform the priests if you have a family member in the hospital.

From the Pastor:

My Dear Parish Family:

Corpus Christi is Latin for the Body of Christ. The Catholic Church throughout the world celebrates the immense gift of the Body and Blood of Jesus left for us as an everlasting memorial. We are able to receive the Body and Blood of Christ every Sunday, or every day if we wish, by attending Mass. We should never receive the Body and Blood of Christ unworthily. If we are aware of any serious sins we have committed or have missed Sunday Mass or a Holy Day of Obligation without going to Confession, we should not receive Holy Communion. We should remain in our pews and pray for a "spiritual communion" with Jesus and then make every effort to go to Confession before receiving the Body and Blood of Christ. The receiving of Holy Communion is very important for the salvation of our souls because it is the Bread of Life! This is why it is always important to receive Jesus, but to do so worthily. We should have the priest, deacon or minister place the Sacred Host on our tongues or in our hands and then immediately place the Host into our mouths. We should take time after receiving Holy Communion to thank God for this awesome gift of life and never just leave Church after Communion. The time after Communion is an important time to spend in prayer for all that we have and to ask for help to be more faithful to God.

Also, as Catholics, we can spend time before the Body of Christ (the Sacred Host) reserved always in the Tabernacle with the red sanctuary lamp always lit in Church to remind us that the Real Presence of Christ is always with us. As Catholics, we believe that although it appears to be bread, the Host is truly Jesus. The same Jesus who lived and died for us, rose from the dead and now lives forever. Therefore, we often take time to sit with our beloved Savior in quiet prayer which is referred to as Adoration. We are fortunate to have an Adoration Chapel available for all the members of the parish to spend time (Tuesdays and Fridays from 9 AM until 7 PM) in the real presence of Jesus (please see page 4 of this bulletin for the Summer Chapel hours.) Or you can come to Church and just sit in the peace and quiet of our beautiful Church (*noticing the red sanctuary lamp always lit*) and be comforted by the knowledge that Jesus is always with us even to the end of the world.

Until next week, Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us. St. Benedict, pray for us! Terence Cardinal Cooke, Servant of God pray for us!

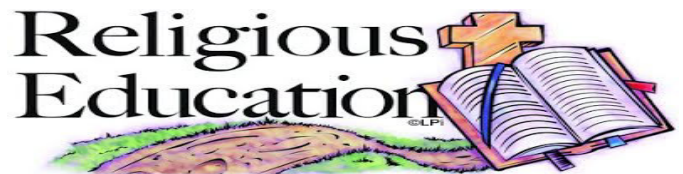

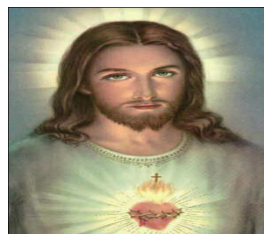
