***Since we are surrounded by

There are many troubles in the world! Jeremiah knew troubles, the ancients lived through troubles, our times are troubled and we have difficulties in our lives. So the author to the Hebrews tells us to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus **who will inspire and perfect our faith**. When we gaze at Christ on the cross we want to also gaze at Christ present at the altar during the Eucharist. The same Lord who was crucified is now alive and present and animating our lives. And more than that--as we receive the Eucharist we **become** the very mystery we are gazing upon. So to "keep our eyes fixed on Jesus" is also to keep an eye out for one another. We may not have time for daily mass but we have plenty of time to observe and honor Christ in one another. We can't always be engaged in quiet prayer in the church, but Jesus is always perfecting our faith as we serve one another.

Reporting Suspected Abuse

If a child or vulnerable adult is in immediate danger, call 911.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

Frequently Asked Questions

What is RCIA? The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults or RCIA is a process by which adults prepare to become full members of the Catholic Church through the reception of the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, ordinarily celebrated in a single liturgy during the Easter Vigil. Those who have already been validly baptized will prepare to make a Profession of Faith, receive First Holy Communion and Confirmation. RCIA is an opportunity to grow closer to the Lord through prayer and learning, a time of continuing formation of faith. This may take 1-2 years.

How is RCIA structured? We begin with a period of inquiry, a time to get acquainted, to ask questions and discern about faith. Weekly instruction begins in September and is based on the four pillars of the Catechism of the Catholic Church: Creed (Beliefs), Sacraments, Morality and Prayer. Participants should also attend Mass every Sunday and the RCIA rites and incorporate prayer into their daily lives.

What support will I have during RCIA? Each adult is asked to choose a sponsor, a confirmed Catholic who is practicing the faith. If you wish, the parish will be glad to find a sponsor for you. Our RCIA team is available at each session to offer hospitality and support. You will receive a schedule of session topics and other materials at the first class. There is no pressure to convert. You are invited to consider the truth of the faith and freely choose to become Catholic.

What materials are used? Each adult receives a copy of the Bible, the book, "Why We're Catholic," and prayer booklets at no cost. These items are yours to keep even if you decide not to continue with RCIA. In addition, you will receive a variety of handouts and other materials weekly. If you already have your own Catechism of the Catholic Church, please feel free to bring it with you. We will also offer resource lists if you wish to do further study.

When do RCIA classes meet? The RCIA program begins September 10, 2019. We meet Tuesday evenings at 6:30 p.m. in the school library. We conclude a week after Easter. Additional time may be needed for individuals to prepare to receive the sacraments.

What if my schedule prevents me from attending on Tuesday evenings? That can happen and we certainly are happy to work with you to accommodate your schedule. Please contact Theresa Smith, tsmith@archkcks.org or 913-299-3370, to schedule individual sessions.

Before RCIA begins, how do I ask questions? You are welcome to call the parish office, 299-3370 to speak with Theresa Smith, Director of Adult Faith Formation or email Theresa at tsmith@archkcks.org. She is in the office Sundays through Thursdays.
