

## January 11, 2021 Minutes

### **Treasure update**

- Janell
  - \$135,00 funds available to spend.
    - \$841.00- December expenses that were taken out.
    - Still need to take \$1,500-2,000 out for Blitz tickets up front costs
  - Need to still order the projector for 3 year old
    - Ben is going to take care of that for her.

### **Projects**

- Classroom windows- Kurt
  - For the windows we sent out a bid package.
  - Wolfe, Carver, Suburban, and Henley Group were all included.
  - December 30- We all met at the school and walked through the building
  - Fiberglass windows were suggested. They are going to go ahead and quote the fiberglass & vinyl window options.
  - January 22- Is when the bids are due. At the February meeting, we will discuss the pros & cons. We will also need to decide at the meeting, so we can let them know who we will go with since they need to know on February 18th.
  - The district uses aluminum windows, so Ben is asking around about whether or not that would be a better choice.
  - Kurt said that there are advantages and disadvantages to all the windows.
- Elementary bathroom renovations-Caitlin
  - We all met on December 30th to discuss options for the restrooms.
  - We have not sent out a bid request at this time.
  - Kiley is in the process of getting in contact with a plumber to see if there are any problems with the plumbing at this time. The urinals on the wall might be causing some issues. \$200 is what it will cost to put a snake down the pipe and look things over.
  - Looking to just replace mirrors, flooring, partitions, toilets, and fixtures.
  - If you tear into the walls, then you will have to make it ADA compliant.
  - Won't have a bid to report at the February meeting.
  - We will know more in March about the possibility of getting those funds.

  - We are unsure if that goes right into the Home & School Account or what that looks like.
