2. **Reminder for Virtual Learners –**

Students may attend virtually only if they exhibit COVID symptoms as listed on the Daily Health Form, have been potentially exposed to the virus, quarantining and/or someone in the household is awaiting COVID test results.

- *Follow your subject schedule as indicated by your teachers. Some classes require live-streaming and others will be facilitated through your Google Classroom accounts.*
- *Be mindful of online etiquette. Must be in school uniform.*
- *Be a self-advocate. Do not hesitate to contact your teachers if you are having ANY difficulties or questions.*
