**Saint Vincent de Paul - North of 60 Project – Rankin Inlet** Congratulations, together we did it! The St. Vincent de Paul Conference of our Parish had a goal to collect 360 packages of pancake mix and monetary donations to buy 360 packages of cookie mix for the people in the Canadian Far North – Rankin Inlet. It is only because of the kindness and generosity of our church community that this goal was met. In fact, we exceeded our expectations!

The cookie mix was purchased and the pancake mix is all packaged. They will soon be loaded on sea containers, along with the food collected by other parishes throughout the city, and taken to the port in Montreal. The containers will be loaded on a ship and transported to Rankin Inlet. Thank you so very much for supporting this initiative. Your generous donations will feed the people who are living in extreme poverty in Canada's north.

**East** – From Brian Coburn Blvd, south on Trim Road, project Trim Road south to Sand Road, continue on Sand Road to Highway 417

**South** – From Sand Road west on Highway 417 to Innes Road

**West** – From Highway 417 east on Innes Road to Green Creek, northeast on Green Creek to St. Joseph Blvd.
