Catechesis of the Good Shepherd - Registration Open for Levels 1, 2, and (new) 3

Good Shepherd Parish enrolment for Levels 1, 2, and 3 of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS) is open for the Fall 2019-Spring 2020 session. CGS is a Christ-centred program that introduces children to biblical and sacramental themes in a way that embraces their youth, joy and capacity for prayer. CGS sessions take place in a Montessori environment called an atrium, located at the parish. Level 1 is designed for children aged 3, 4 and 5, Level 2 is for those aged 6, 7, and 8, and Level 3 is for children aged 9-12. Level 1 sessions will take place on Thursday OR Saturday morning, while Level 2 sessions will take place on Thursday evening OR Saturday afternoon. New this year, Level 3 will be offered on Tuesday evening.
