RITE OF ENROLLMENT

An enrollment ceremony will be held at all Masses on **October 5th and 6th** for the children preparing to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation and First Communion. You and your child **may attend any one of these ceremonies**. During this rite these children will be requested to stand with their parents and to express their desire for Holy Communion and parents renew the promises they made when their children were baptized, promising to help them prepare for communion. As members of Good Shepherd Parish they will also affirm their commitment to support these children on this journey through prayers.

- We ask that you arrive **early**, at least 15 minutes before mass, since the Enrolment Ceremony will take place at the beginning of Mass.
- Write your child's name in the sign-in sheet.
- The priest will call the child's name at the beginning of the mass and the parents will take the child in front and will stand facing the altar.
