ADDRESSING THE ISSUE OF THE CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)

The Archdiocese passes along some recommended precautions, which The Good Shepherd Parish leadership and ministers will follow and which we ask all parishioners to do also:

- wash one's hands (Hand-sanitizer dispensers are mounted on the walls for parishioners' use. Washing your hands with soap and water in the washrooms is also an option.);
- if you feel unwell, please stay home; the Sunday obligation does not bind those who are ill;
- suspend the greeting of peace; and
- (continue to) suspend the reception of Holy Communion from the chalice.

As recommended by the Archdiocese, we will follow these precautions throughout Lent, unless and until other decisions are taken. Thank you all for your cooperation in this serious matter.

CANADA EXTENDS CATEGORIES OF THOSE ELIGIBLE FOR EUTHANASIA, ASSISTED SUICIDE

Our Federal Parliament is considering extending the categories of those who may be permitted to request Medical Aid in Dying (MAiD), which masks what is really taking place – euthanasia and assisted suicide.

Cardinal Thomas Collins, Archbishop of Toronto has written a powerful statement on this issue, dated February 25, 2020, which can be found in our website:

In this statement he explains what is taking place and he encourages Catholics to write to their Members of Parliament to express their disapproval.
