Extended Care Fees

Before Care: \$8/ scholar \$10/ family
After Care: \$10/ scholar \$12/ family

All extended care balance must be current or the service will be denied.

Extended Care payments are due in a timely manner. In the event that it is determined you balance is too high the result will be denial of services and your scholar will not be allowed to attend extended care, participate in field trips and extracurricular activities.

Before Care - (7:00 – 7:45 a.m.)

- Breakfast is served as part of the morning care program beginning at 7:45 a.m. There is no cost for breakfast.
- Please Note: There is no adult supervision on Our Lady of Perpetual Help School's campus prior to 7:45 a.m. Any child who arrives at school prior to 7:45 a.m. must report to morning-care and will be charged the morning-care fee.

After-School Care- (3:40 - 6:00 p.m.)

- Scholars in aftercare will be provided a snack and juice. Outside snacks are not allowed.
- For late pick-ups there will be a late charge of \$10.00 for every five minutes past 6 p.m. This late payment is due by the following morning. If late more than three times, you will need to consider an alternative pick up plan, or care for your child.
- Please Note: There is no adult supervision on Our Lady of Perpetual Help School's campus after 3:40. Any child who has not been picked up by 3:40 will be sent to after-care and charged the after-school care fee.
- Children not picked up within ten minutes of the end of extra-curricular activities (band, choir, sports, cheerleading, etc.) must report to after-school care and will be charged the after-school care fee.
- Students left after carpool, who are not allowed to attend aftercare, are brought to the office for phone calls. **Students not picked up by 4:15 pm are reported abandoned.**

FINANCIAL POLICIES

Your child will not be allowed to participate in extracurricular activities and may not attend field trips if you do not bring your account up to date. This is a self-funding service provided to our families. The extended care program will end if payroll cannot be met. A service was provided and payment is expected. Please pay your account balance. If you have questions or concerns please call the office 504-464-0531.
