



## CHRIST THE TEACHER SCHOOL

### Before & After Care Program

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**Before Care:** We have a teacher supervised morning program available for Christ the Teacher students from 7:00 am – 7:50 a.m. Students **MUST** be dropped off at the cafeteria door. The cost is \$7.00/per student each day of attendance. Families will be billed on the 15<sup>th</sup> and the 30<sup>th</sup> of the month. **STUDENTS ARE NOT TO BE DROPPED OFF ON SCHOOL PROPERTY AND LEFT UNATTENDED.**

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**After Care:** Our afterschool program begins at 2:30 (PK dismissal) until 6:30 p.m. on regular school days. The program will be held in the cafeteria and parents will use the cafeteria door for pick up. **PARENTS MUST COMPLETE AN AFTERCARE REGISTRATION FORM IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE AFTERCARE PROGRAM.** Parents must sign their child/children out. The chart below indicates the fees for students attending the Aftercare Program.

The program end promptly at 6:30 p.m. A late fee of \$2.00/per minute will be charged after 6:30 p.m. and the emergency contact person will be notified to pick up the student. Failure to



make payment will result in a \$35.00 late fee and continued failure to make payments will result in removal from the program.

**Every child must be registered to participate in Before/After care. The attached form must be given to the school prior than your child's first day of attendance. The registration fee is \$10.00 for either or both.**

Pick up will be at the cafeteria door. It is mandatory to sign out each student, please **PRINT YOUR NAME** followed by your **SIGNATURE** as you leave.

Students will participate in snack time, homework time and recreational activities. Students are expected to behave accordingly to the clearly defined expectations of the program supervisor. Parents will be notified of any discipline issues. If the issues are not resolved, the student will be removed from the program.

#### **COVID PANDEMIC UPDATE:**

- **Masks are mandatory.**
- **Students are encouraged to bring a snack to eat. We are not allowed to give food to anyone or allow the use of the vending machine.**
- **Students are encouraged to bring their own wipes for cleaning their hands often.**
- **Students will be placed at separate tables throughout the cafeteria. Siblings will be placed at the same table.**
- **We are not allowed to have children play with the toys. Children are encouraged to bring a small tote (no larger than 14 quart) with toys to play with. Parents should mark it clearly with their name and grade. All toy totes must be brought home to be sanitized.**
- **When the weather permits, the aftercare moderator will bring the children outside. They will be allowed to have snack and to play for a little while.**
- **Parents should report to the cafeteria door for pick-up as always. You will be able to text Gordana to tell her you are on your way so they can get your child packed up.**
- **You will be met at the door with your child. You will be asked to sign for your child at the door with a disposable pencil. Please be sure you are wearing a mask when you come to the door. NO one is allowed in the school building.**
- **Bills for aftercare will be sent home on a weekly basis. It must be paid through the website. We will not handle any money through the school. You can find the link under the tab for aftercare.**
- **The area for aftercare and bathrooms will be sanitized each day.**
