### EASTER NOVENA

**THOUGH His Resurrection Jesus Christ was made known to us as God's Son in power, for He was obedient into death and exalted as Lord of all. God chose His Son to be the one who suffered and die for our sins. Because of His obedience He was raised up as Lord to all. By conquering death through His own power in His Resurrection, Jesus has shown Himself Master of life and death. Therefore He is true God and true man, Our Savior.**

**By his Death and Resurrection Jesus Redeemed mankind form slavery to sin and to the devil. In obedience to His Father's Will He gave Himself for us in His Passion and arose from the dead that He might redeem us from sin and make us a people pleasing to the Father. He is the Messiah, God's own Son. He often said that what He was doing was done that the Scriptures might be fulfilled, because He saw His Father's Will in them.**

**We were slaves of the devil because of Original Sin and because of our personal sins. But Jesus made us free with the freedom of the children of God, for by His Resurrection He destroyed death and gave us the life of grace, Risen truly, the Lord gives us the Divine life of grace and pours His Holy Spirit Upon Us.**

Let us pray the Divine Mercy which starts Good Friday and Ends Easter Saturday.
