Baptism: Children should be baptized within the first few months after birth. Baptism should take place in one's proper parish. Registered parishioners should contact **Fr. Richard** at the Office for information regarding the selection of Godparents, any required preparations and the date and time of Baptism.

Reconciliation: Confessions are normally heard on Saturday, before the 4:00 PM evening Mass. Other opportunities are possible by appointment.

Eucharistic Adoration: Spend a refreshing hour before the Lord in prayer in our daily chapel, from the conclusion of morning Mass until 3:00 PM on Thursdays.

Marriages: Either the bride or the groom must be a registered parishioner of St. Joseph/ St. Ann Parish. At least six months of preparation time is required in our Diocese. Weddings are never booked by phone or by third-parties; **a personal interview is required.** Call the office for an appointment.

Funerals: Contact the office to make necessary arrangements for the funeral liturgy.
