3:15-3:40 PM. Other opportunities are possible by appointment by calling Father

Eucharistic Adoration: Spend a refreshing hour before the Lord in prayer in our daily
chapel, from the conclusion of morning Mass until 3:00 PM on Thursdays.

Marriages: Either the bride or the groom must be a registered parishioner of St. Joseph/ St.
Ann Parish. At least six months of preparation time is required in our Diocese. Weddings are
never booked by phone or by third-parties; a **personal interview is required**. Call the office
for an appointment.

Funerals: Contact the office to make necessary arrangements for the funeral liturgy.

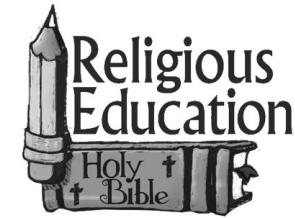
The Annual C.C.W. Christmas Party has been scheduled for Sunday, December 1 at 2:00 PM in the hall. More info to come later...
