Monsignor Francis I. Malone, Bishop-elect of the Diocese of Shreveport, will be ordained as the third Bishop of Shreveport on Tuesday, January 28, 2020. It will be at 2:00 PM at the Shreveport Convention Center. They are anticipating seating for 2500, therefore tickets will not be required. A special reception will also be held at the Convention Center at the conclusion of the ordination Mass.

Evening Vespers will be conducted on Monday, January 27, 2020 I the Cathedral of St. John Berchmans at 6:00 PM. This will be an opportunity for Bishop-elect Malone to meet and greet members of religious orders and persons from the political community. This service is open to anyone. Tickets will not be required.

Baptism: Children should be baptized within the first few months after birth. Baptism should take place in one's proper parish. Registered parishioners should contact **Fr. Richard** at the Office for information regarding the selection of Godparents, any required preparations and the date and time of Baptism.

Reconciliation: Confessions are normally heard on Saturdays before the mass from 3:15-3:40 PM. Other opportunities are possible by appointment by calling Father Richards's cell at 318-282-9477

Eucharistic Adoration: Spend a refreshing hour before the Lord in prayer in our daily chapel, from the conclusion of morning Mass until 3:00 PM on Thursdays.

Marriages: Either the bride or the groom must be a registered parishioner of St. Joseph/ St. Ann Parish. At least six months of preparation time is required in our Diocese. Weddings are never booked by phone or by third-parties; a **personal interview is required**. Call the office for an appointment.

Funerals: Contact the office to make necessary arrangements for the funeral liturgy.

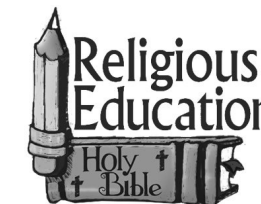
