Eucharistic Adoration: Spend a refreshing hour before the Lord in prayer in our daily chapel, from the conclusion of morning Mass until 3:00 PM on Thursdays.

Marriages: Either the bride or the groom must be a registered parishioner of St. Joseph/ St. Ann Parish. At least six months of preparation time is required in our Diocese. Weddings are never booked by phone or by third-parties; **a personal interview is required.** Call the office for an appointment.

Funerals: Contact the office to make necessary arrangements for the funeral liturgy.

It will be at 2:00 PM at the Shreveport Convention Center.** They are anticipating seating for 2500, therefore tickets will not be required. A special reception will also be held at the Convention Center at the conclusion of the ordination Mass.

Evening Vespers will be conducted on Monday, *January 27, 2020* I the Cathedral of St. John Berchmans at 6:00 PM. This will be an opportunity for Bishop-elect Malone to meet and greet members of religious orders and persons from the political community. This service is open to anyone. Tickets will not be required.

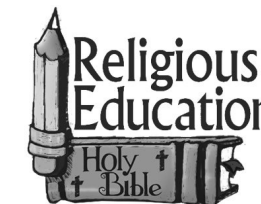
