When you come to second grade after the summer you will need to be sure you have some supplies. You will need:

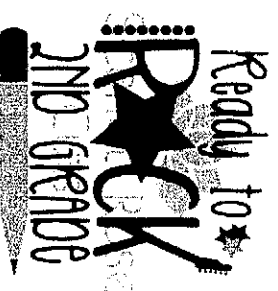
- Sharpened pencils-at least three

- At least one container of disinfectant wipes (fingers crossed)

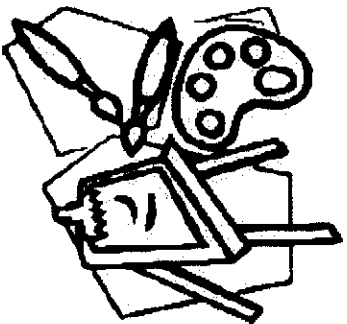

Art Supply List 2020-21
