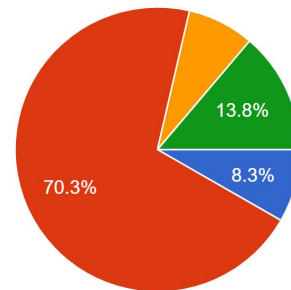

290 responses

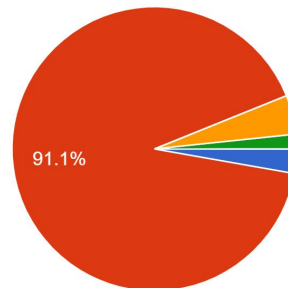

180 responses



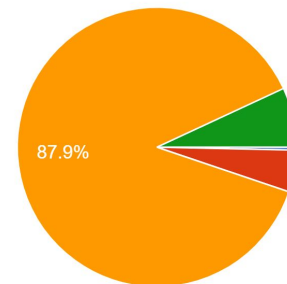

290 responses

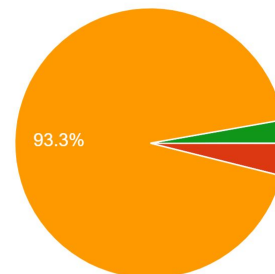


- Too hard - my child could not do any of the work independently

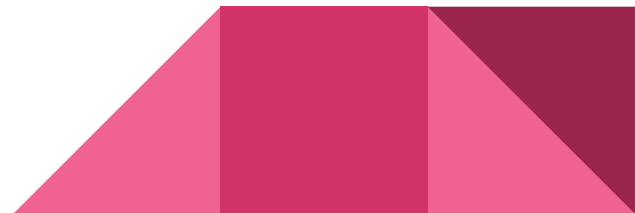

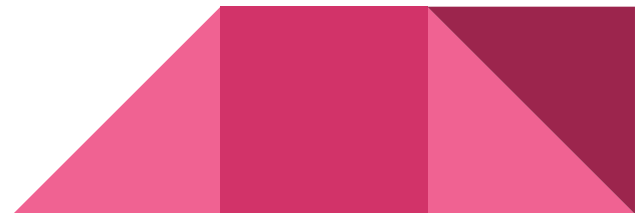
