


Liturgical Preparedness Plan Revision September 15, 2020


The following excerpt from the Office of Worship directives dated September 4, 2020 hereby replaces the directions on the distribution of Holy Communion published on page 2 of the previous Liturgical Preparedness Plan:


“...Pastors now have the option to distribute Holy Communion to the faithful in **Communion lines at the usual time** during Mass. With this option, the priest or deacon may wear the chasuble or dalmatic during distribution. All other hygienic practices—ministers and communicants both wear masks, use hand sanitizer, maintain 6 feet of distance, etc.—remain in effect.”

Directions for Communion distribution will be given at Mass, distributing section by section, and separating distribution on the tongue from distribution on the hand.

At the conclusion of Mass, after the Blessing and Dismissal, members of the congregation are asked to remain in place to continue prayers of thanksgiving in silence, and then gradually leave the Church, maintaining appropriate distancing.
