Brick and Mortar Plan

Online learning plan is available for families that are quarantined or self-isolation.



Every student gets a device to use at school! Devices will be sanitized daily.



Hand sanitizer stations will be installed in every classroom and in the lobby.



Student and staff temperatures should be taken before leaving home. They will also be checked upon arrival with a contactless thermometer.



Teachers will be trained on SeeSaw, an online learning management system. They will also be trained on the single sign on platform, Clever.



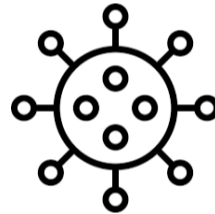
Classrooms will be disinfected at least twice daily by janitorial staff. Switches, handrails, door handles, and keyboards will be frequently cleaned.



One way traffic will be implemented in the hallways.



Hand washing will be incorporated into classroom schedules at least 4 times per day.



Sick children will wait in a designated area away from the office to be picked up.



Plexiglass barriers will be placed in the office, preschool classroom, and kindergarten classrooms.



Teachers will wear cloth masks or face shields at school.



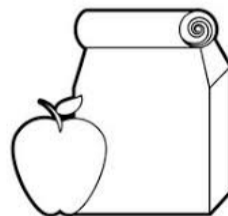
Alternative arrival and dismissal plans will be implemented.

Classrooms will not exceed 50% capacity, limited transitions will take place, and students will eat lunch in the classroom.

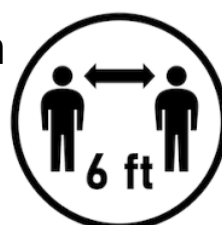


Parents may have to provide a sack lunch and their own transportation.
