Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 128:1-5

The Responsorial Psalm is a wisdom psalm that speaks of the blessings received by those who walk in the way of the Lord.

The images used in this psalm are societal. The first has to do with the blessing that one would receive in one's work. One would eat the fruit of one's handiwork.

Remember how, when Adam was punished for his sin, he was told that he would work hard but only receive a scanty recompense. Here the curse would be reversed, and one would no longer be frustrated.

The second image is the blessing of a happy family life. Typically, the blessing is seen in terms of many children.

Finally, one's larger society would also be blessed, for Zion and Jerusalem would prosper.
