Gospel: Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21

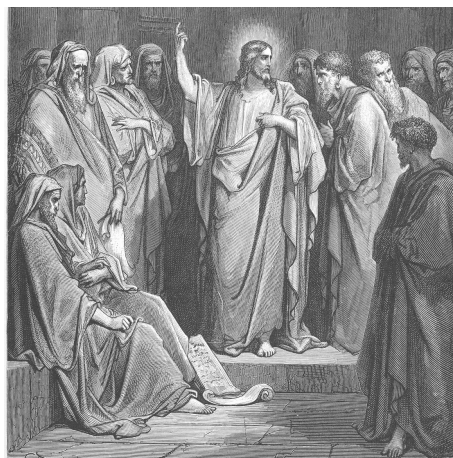
## Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 19:8-10, 15

The Responsorial Psalm comes from the second half of Psalm 19. It begins with six synonyms for the law of the Lord, praising God for the law's goodness. It is odd, however, that there would be only six synonyms. Seven was the perfect number in the Bible, and six references to the law would imply that it somehow lacked perfection.

The last section clarifies why the psalmist formed this pattern. He speaks of the words of his mouth and the thoughts of his heart. This is the seventh reference.

The law is only perfect when it is interiorized (found in the thoughts of one's heart) and when one gives witness to it in the way one lives (the words of one's mouth).

Beginning in January, the gift shop will be open on the **last Sunday** of each month after the **7am Mass**.

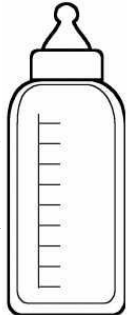
## FOOD DONATION THANK YOU
