Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 103:1-4, 6-8, 11

The Responsorial Psalm identified God as the God who hears our pleas and responds to our needs with generosity. Psalm 103 is a thanksgiving to render gratitude to that God.

The psalm is filled with words that describe the caring and compassionate attitude that God demonstrates to the people of Israel and to us, words such as kindness, compassion, merciful and gracious.

This fills us with a sense of awe, for God's kindness and generosity are truly beyond our comprehension.

Justice means giving each person what that person truly deserves.

If God practiced strict justice, then we could not survive, for we have all sinned and all deserve God's punishment. But God has put aside our guilt and surrounded us with mercy and love.
