### Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 126:1-6

This Responsorial Psalm is both a thanksgiving for the great things that the Lord did to bring his chosen people back from their exile in Babylon an appeal to continue to help them.

The people expected that once they returned from exile everything would be fine. Yet, when they arrived in Israel, it was anything but fine.

The city of Jerusalem and the temple had been destroyed. The fields were barren and overgrown. Drought afflicted them year after year.

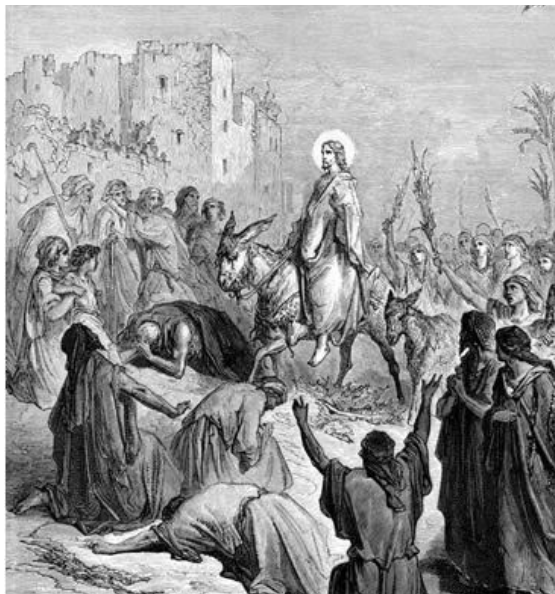
The people could not defend themselves from the depredations of the desert nomads (for they had not yet rebuilt the city walls).

The people therefore prayed that the Lord would intervene once again and bless their efforts with an abundant harvest. On the one hand, this psalm can almost seem like the attitude that says, "what have you done for me lately?"

But it could also be understood to be a profession of trust that God would always continue to intervene to help his beloved people.
