HOLY WEEK & EASTER SCHEDULE

HOLY THURSDAY - APRIL 18

Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7pm

Christ's institution of ordination to the Priesthood is manifested in the Mass and how through this Sacrament, the grace of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass flows from the sanctuary into the whole world; washing the feet of all who walk in His light.

Mass will conclude with a candlelight procession of the church recalling Christ's departure to a secluded place in preparation for His ultimate sacrifice.

The inside of the church is stark. Artwork is removed, statues are covered and candles are extinguished. Christ's long and painful journey of carrying His wooden cross to the hill of crucifixion and execution is solemnly recalled.

EASTER VIGIL - APRIL 20

Mass and Christian Initiation at 8pm

An evening bonfire in the piazza initiates the triumph of light over darkness. An evening of Scriptural meditations on all the major events leading up to humanity's eventual salvation are reflected upon. Adults are baptized and initiated into the Christian faith therefore becoming members of Christ's body, His one and holy Church.

Traditional Latin Mass at 7am

English at 8:30am and 11:00am

The whole community, as they do every Sunday, gather around the Lord's Table celebrating His Resurrection from the dead and rejoicing in His heavenly and bodily presence in the midst of all present.
