Almighty ever-living God, lead us to share in the joys of heaven, so that the humble flock may reach where the brave Shepherd has gone before. Who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.

Today's Mass Readings

1st Reading: Acts 13:14, 43-52

2nd Reading: Revelation 7:9, 14b-17

Gospel: John 10:27-30

Gospel Reflection: Sheep are not the most intelligent of animals. They often graze on hillsides that are too steep and they fall over on their backs. Once they have fallen over, they cannot right themselves. If they were to be left there, they would die. Because of this, the shepherd has to keep a constant eye on the sheep lest they place themselves in danger.

Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 100:1-3, 5

The Responsorial Psalm celebrates the fact that Jesus is our Good Shepherd and we are the sheep of His flock.

This is the theme that is contained in the Gospel today, but it is also found in the First Reading.

That passage from Acts of the Apostles shows how Jesus sends His Spirit to guide us in our every action.

This fact fills us with joy. We are not left to struggle through life by our own devices.

We have a loving shepherd who will guide us with kindness and gentleness.

There are no limitations to the goodness and love of God, for they extend to every nation upon the earth and every era of history. God's mercy is all powerful and eternal. God will always be faithful to His promises.
