Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 145:8-13

The Responsorial Psalm is a series of verses taken from Psalm 145. This psalm is a hymn of praise. It is an alphabetic psalm, with each verse of the psalm beginning with a successive letter of the Hebrew alphabet.

The verses used today speak of God's kingdom. The term "kingdom" should not be understood as a reality that exists in a particular time or place.

It is better understood as the reign of God (for it is more of a verb than a noun). It exists whenever and wherever God's law is obeyed and His love revealed.

There are a series of adjectives to describe the reign of God. Words such as gracious, merciful and kindness abounds.

God does not reign through terror and rage, but by conquering our hearts with His love. He is the king of our hearts

This is not a message intended only for those who belong to the Old and New Israel. As we hear in the last section of this psalm, it is a message for all of the children of Adam (all members of the human race).

It is also a message that all should hear until the very end of time, for God's dominion endures through all generations.
