## Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 67:2-6, 8

Psalm 67 is a hymn of thanksgiving that is based upon the blessing of Aaron found in the Book of Numbers (6:24-26).

The psalm celebrates the fact that God has blessed Israel abundantly. Yet, it is not only Israel that should give thanks to the Lord.

The psalm calls upon all the nations on the earth to give praise to the Lord, for Yahweh is the God of all peoples.

The reason for this gratitude is the fact that God's blessing upon Israel was only the beginning. God's blessing was a model of the way that God would now treat all peoples upon the earth.

They were now all His chosen people, all His beloved.

We have seen this in the First Reading when we heard about the mission of the early Church to the pagans, to the very ends of the earth.

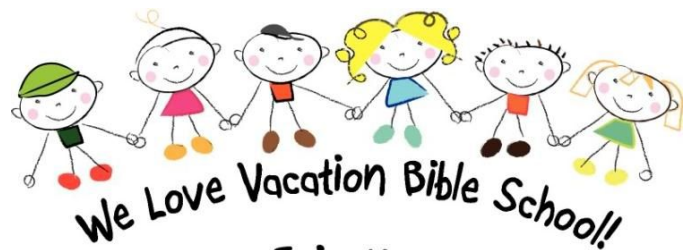
