Reflection on the Gospel: *Corpus Christi Sunday has long been associated with a procession of the Blessed Sacrament around one's church and/or one's neighborhood.*

Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 110:1-4

The Responsorial Psalm is taken from Psalm 110, a royal psalm. It was written to commemorate the enthronement of a new king in Israel.

In ancient times, kings were also considered to be priests. Remember how David sacrificed animals when he brought the Ark of the Covenant into Jerusalem and how Solomon sacrificed animals when he dedicated the temple in Jerusalem.

The proclamation at the end of the psalm was intended for the new king, for like Melchizedek, the new king was both a priest and king.

This was also true of Jesus, who is king and priest (and also prophet).

In fact, it is even more true of Jesus, for he is a king forever.

It is also true of us, for in our Baptism we are given a share in Christ's dignity. In that sacrament we are given the dignity of priest, prophet, and king.
