Gospel: Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

Reflection: *What does it mean to be a disciple of the Lord? How does that change the way I think and act?*

Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 66:1-7, 16, 20

Psalm 66 is a hymn of thanksgiving, both for what the Lord had done for the nation and for what he had done for the psalmist.

God is both a God who guides the great events of history and a God who is concerned with every individual.

It is interesting that, while the events of which the psalmist is speaking involved Israel, he calls upon all the nations of the earth to give praise to the Lord.

The reason is that they had witnessed the covenant that God made with Israel, and they had also witnessed the ways that God reached out to save Israel in her times of need (during the Exodus from Egypt, for example).

But the nations can also rejoice for they are being invited into that covenant in the Gospel passage that we hear today.
