## Today's Mass Readings

1st Reading: Genesis 18:1-10a

2nd Reading: Colossians 1:24-28

Gospel: Luke 10:38-42

Reflection: *"What do I consider true hospitality? What is most difficult for me to share (ie: money, talents, time)?*

*Any form of ministry can easily degenerate into an attempt to complete a series of tasks rather than be of service to the people whom we are supposedly serving. Jesus always took time for the individual and treated each person with sacred respect."*

## Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 15:1a-5

The First Reading spoke of hospitality and welcoming God into one's home. The Gospel speaks of the same thing, for it presents the story of Martha and Mary and their hospitality toward Jesus.

The Responsorial Psalm asks who can be a host to the Lord. The answer given is a standard wisdom teaching: the one who lives a moral, righteous life. Among those things that such a wise person will do is to speak the truth and not gossip.

The wise one will stay away from those who live sinful lives, and will praise and associate with those who live according to God's ways.

The wise one will also use money carefully, not making extravagant profits at another's expense and not selling justice.

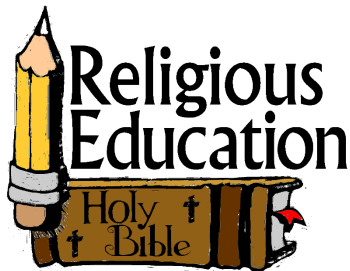
