## THIS WEEK'S REFLECTIONS

*O God, protector of those who hope in You, without whom nothing has firm foundation, nothing is holy, bestow in abundance Your mercy upon us and grant that, with You as our ruler and guide, we may use the good things that pass in such a way as to hold fast even now to those that ever endure. Through our Lord, Jesus Christ, who lives and reigns with You in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.*

## Today's Mass Readings

1st Reading: Genesis 18:20-32

2nd Reading: Colossians 2:12-14

Gospel: Luke 11:1-13

Reflection: *"You have received a Spirit of adoption, through which we cry, Abba, Father."* The Alleluia Verse reminds us of the incredible dignity with which God treats us. We are not slaves; we have been called to be children of a loving God.

## Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 138:1-3, 6-8

The theme of the First Reading and the Gospel is prayer, and that theme is continued in the Responsorial Psalm. Psalm 138 is of thanksgiving, but the verses chosen for the psalm of today's Responsorial are those that speak about God's faithful response to our prayer and need.

God answers our prayers with kindness and truth. Kindness means that God is compassionate in his dealings with us. Truth means that God is faithful to the promises that He has made.

God also answers the prayers of the poor and lowly. God is their source of hope, for humans often discount them since they are powerless.

Yet, God does not look at us according to the opinions of human beings. God reaches out to those who most need Him and fills them with His blessings.

Throughout the psalm, there are hints of Hebrew argumentation. God is told that His name is great above all things for he has answered our prayers.

The implication is that if He does not answer them, His name will not be as respected.
