## Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 90:1, 3-6, 12-14, 17

The Responsorial Psalm is a series of verses taken from Psalm 90.

That psalm is a lamentation, but the verses used today give another impression. They emphasize the fragility of human life and the greatness of God.

The message developed is that if we are so weak and God is so great, then we must depend upon God and God will respond to our needs.

The theme here agrees well with that of the First Reading and the Gospel. Those readings speak of the futility of trusting in our own resources, for our God is the only one who can respond to our needs. It is especially foolish to trust in one's riches.

The psalm, on the other hand, starts with that premise: that we can do nothing on our own. We are like the grass that springs up in the morning and then withers by the evening.

The psalmist presents this truth, and then tells God that it is up to him. If he does not provide his gracious care, then we will not have a chance.

This is why we call upon God to 'prosper the work of our hands for us.' He is the only one who can bring our work to completion.
