## THIS WEEK'S REFLECTIONS

God of might, giver of every good gift, put into our hearts the love of your name, so that, by deepening our sense of reverence, and, by your watchful care, keep safe what you have nurtured. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

### Today's Mass Readings

1st Reading: Sirach 3:17-18, 20, 28-29

2nd Reading: Hebrews 12:18-19, 22-24a

Gospel: Luke 14:1, 7-14

Reflection: *Human beings rarely have only one layer of motivation. We might think that we are doing something for all the right motives, but there may be a mix of motives as to why we are doing those things. Some of those motives might be quite altruistic, others a bit selfish.*

*It is essential that we be brutally honest with ourselves concerning all these motives. When we know them, we can deal with them and purify them. If, on the other hand, we try to kid ourselves into thinking that we are acting from a perfectly pure motivation, then our somewhat less generous motives will tend to blindside us. We will end up doing something (even the right thing) for the wrong reason.*

### Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 68:4-5, 6-7, 10-11

The Responsorial Psalm praises the LORD for his goodness to the psalmist and to the people of Israel.

This goodness is especially expressed in the way that the LORD treats the poor.

The widow and the orphan are the exemplars of those who have no one to stand up for them.

The LORD is also the one who provides a home for those who are homeless and who sets prisoners free.
