## THIS WEEK'S REFLECTIONS

O God, who founded all the commands of your sacred Law upon love of you and of our neighbor, grant that, by keeping your precepts, we may merit to attain eternal life. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

### Today's Mass Readings

1st Reading: Amos 8:4-7

2nd Reading: 1 Timothy 2:1-8

Gospel: Luke 16:1-13

Reflection: *What type of image would describe our parish? Most often we run our parishes as holding operations. We try to keep everyone in the parish satisfied lest we lose them to another parish or religion. What would our parish life be like if we ran it like political campaigns are run? People running for political office would do almost anything to attain their goal. Would that we put that much of ourselves into our willingness to share our faith.*

### Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 113:1-2, 4-6, 7-8

The Responsorial Psalm is a hymn of praise to the Lord who is king over all the earth.

This psalm is a reminder that we cannot hide our activities from God. We cannot pretend that we can do things that he does not see.

We must live in a manner that is consistent with what we say we are. We cannot say we are Christians and live in a way that might give scandal to others (especially if they were to know we are Christians).

This means that we must have a radical trust in the providence of God. We cannot pretend that it all depends upon our own efforts.

If we depend only on ourselves, then we will do whatever we can to succeed (often betraying the things we hold most precious, e.g., our family, our faith, etc.).

We have to be prudent in providing for ourselves and our family, and we have to remember to keep our priorities in perspective.

## SEXUAL ABUSE COMPENSATION PROGRAM

The Independent Victim Compensation Program (ICP), a program sponsored by the Diocese of San Diego to assist victim-survivors who were abused as minors by priests of this diocese, began accepting applications. The ICP is independent and not controlled by the Church. There is no time limit on when the abuse may have taken place. The program will consider all claims, regardless of how long ago the abuse occurred. No attorney is necessary and there are no fees of any kind. U.S. Residency is also not required. - ❖ The prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:25-35)
- ❖ The flight into Egypt (Matthew 2:13-15)
- ❖ Loss of the Child Jesus for three days (Luke 2:41-50)
- ❖ Mary meets Jesus on his way to Calvary (Luke 23:27-31; John 19:17)
- ❖ Crucifixion and Death of Jesus (John 19:25-30)
- ❖ The body of Jesus being taken from the Cross (Psalm 130; Luke 23:50-54; John 19:31-37)
- ❖ The burial of Jesus (Isaiah 53:8; Luke 23:50-56; John 19:38-42; Mark 15:40-47)
