Ps 146:7, 8-9, 9-10

Psalm 146 is a hymn of praise and thanksgiving to the LORD who is good and loving and generous.

The way that God expresses this goodness is by being the refuge of those in need. He is a guarantor of justice for those who have no one to defend them.

This psalm uses the traditional images for the poor: captives, hungry, blind, strangers, widows, and orphans.

If we are faithful followers of God, we will reach out to those same people.

The measure of any society is how well it treats those who are the powerless. The measure for how much we are Christian is how much we act as Christ would have acted.

It is also a call to look around at those who surround us (our friends, our family, the people at work or school, etc.) and see how they are also among the weak and broken (for we all have our difficulties and needs).
