## THIS WEEK'S REFLECTIONS

Almighty ever-living God, who in the abundance of your kindness surpass the merits and the desires of those who entreat you, pour out your mercy upon us to pardon what conscience dreads and to give what prayer does not dare to ask. Through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever.

### Today's Mass Readings

1st Reading: Habakkuk 1:2-3; 2:2-4

2nd Reading: 2 Timothy 1:6-8, 13-14

Gospel: Luke 17:5-10

Reflection: *Is it wrong to have moments of doubt? Faith is both a gift and a response. It seems as if some have received a greater measure of that gift and they do not have as many doubts as others have. God only asks each of us to respond as well as we can to the gift we have received and not to be perfect.*

### Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 95: 1-2, 6-7, 8-9

The Responsorial Psalm continues the theme of keeping our trust in the ways of Almighty God.

God is our rock and our salvation. He has delivered us from our difficulties in the past, and he will intervene again when we most need him.

We should be filled with gratitude and sing our thanksgiving to God for all that he has done and will do for us.

The alternative is to rebel against God like the Israelites did when they tested him in the desert at Meribah and Massah. God had just liberated the people of Israel from their slavery in Egypt.

He performed wondrous deeds to set them free. He fed them and gave them water to drink. He protected them from all of their enemies.

They should have trusted in God, but they did not.
