The Responsorial Psalm is a psalm of trust in the LORD. It is an affirmation that God will always provide for his children and respond to their needs.

Does this mean that, if we have faith, nothing bad will ever happen to us? No, for there is an old saying that God always answers our prayers, but sometimes God's answer is, "No!"

Our vision is limited, for we view and judge reality according to what we know. God can see things that we cannot begin to understand.

God can see the end results of actions that are only beginning to happen. God, as a loving parent, might allow things to happen for which we can see no meaning.

Yet, good might come of these things (admittedly, it is often only in a very long-term perspective).

And so, God guards us from all evil. But God does not solve our every problem. He only promises that he will accompany us in whatever happens in our lives.
