### Responsorial Psalm Meditation

Ps 34:2-3, 17-18, 19, 23

The Responsorial Psalm is a hymn of praise to God who is good and compassionate. He is gracious and merciful and slow to anger.

Sometimes it is difficult to reconcile this picture of a merciful God with the image of an angry God in the Old Testament.

One possible explanation is that God was not angry at us; God was angry at our sin.

God viewed sin as something that was destructive to his beloved children. It was a poison that robbed his children of their vitality. He hated sin. Yet, he still loved his children.

Unfortunately, our response to the anger was confusion. We thought that God was angry with us, but God was angry at what we were doing.

God is not capricious and vindictive. God is "faithful in all his words and holy in all his works."

Even when we are not faithful, God is faithful to us. Even when we turn our backs on God, God will be compassionate to us.
