## 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

*The church accompanies us on our journey through life, through the seasons of the year and within the changing circumstances of our daily lives. The following themes can serve as a guide along this path. They can be used individually, as a family or in groups.*

**Remember:** Who would you trust to set you up on a blind date or to introduce you to new friends? A family member, colleague, an app or no one (I only trust my own judgment)? Some people are happy to keep their head down low. Have you ever had to work behind the scenes without receiving recognition? Have you ever seen untapped potential in someone and gave them the resources to see it blossom?

**Read:** John 1:29-34 'Behold, the Lamb of God'

**Reflect:** Sometimes it's easier to be part of a group and follow a leader who can be inspirational but also remote at the same time. John the Baptist provided his followers with quick and certain answers and spiritual solutions, including dramatic and powerful rituals in a unique setting. But John pointed his followers to Jesus, who was completely different in teaching style and seemed more patient and mysterious. Whereas John was like a lion in the desert, Jesus was like a lamb.

**Review:** From the perspective of John, when he saw Jesus approaching 1. John fell into a trance and saw Jesus from a heavenly perspective? 2. John was confident that Jesus could now take over for him? 3. John was expecting him? 4. John was challenged to see his cousin Jesus as if for the first time? 5. John knew of the circumstances of both Jesus and his own conception and birth?

**Respond:** From your own perspective, what image of Jesus comes first to mind? 1. A dynamic individual who would stand out in a crowd? 2. A celestial being radiating light? 3. A serious goal-oriented individual? 4. Someone I would run towards or away from? 4. I hope He's not looking at me? 5. He's moving towards me or I'm moving towards him?
