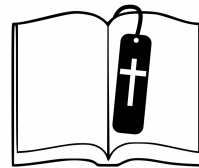

VOCATION DISCERNMENT WEEKEND

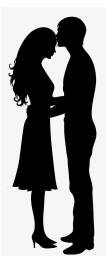

THE CHOICE FOR LIFE

40 Days for Life Spring Campaign begins Feb. 26-April 5th. Through prayer, fasting, and prayer vigils, join the pro-life community to ask for God's intervention to end abortion. Abortion was the leading cause of death worldwide in 2019. About 42 million babies were killed in this one year. Through 40 Days for Life, 16,742 babies have been saved from abortion, 104 abortion facilities closed and 196 abortion workers had a change of heart.
