GOSPEL: MARK 1:12-15

The vast majority of us can and should beat our chest and say with the publican: "O God, be merciful to me, a sinner." And merciful he will be if we turn to him with true humility. He may not remove all our temptations, all our wrong inclinations, but he will give us the grace to overcome them if we sincerely seek his aid.

## THE CHURCH COMPASS

The Church accompanies us on our journey through life, through the seasons of the year and within the changing circumstances of our daily lives. The following themes can serve as a guide along this path. They can be used individually, as a family or in groups.

**REMEMBER:** What's the longest driving trip you ever took? How did you plan for it? Maps? Pit Stops or overnights? Did you overpack, bring only the essentials? Have you ever walked around a city at night? When traveling, do you keep to the tourist areas, drive the freeways or the back streets or take the public transport? As a tourist or visiting from out-of-town, how do you tell locals apart from visitors?

**READ:** Mark 1:12-15

**REFLECT:** The Holy Spirit guided Christ into the wilderness for over a month. Even like a large city, there were places that were derelict and forgotten, hidden dangers and sinister looking shadows, eyes watching Him from the darkness, and secret attractions and a charming con man wanting to sell Him something for nothing.

**REVIEW:** From Christ's perspective, why might He have gone off the beaten track? 1. He needed a retreat to get away from distractions? 2. He needed to confront His fears and temptations? 3. He had a score to settle with the devil. 4. Preparing for His public ministry, He needed to test His endurance levels? 5. He knew that He was protected by His divine power?

**RESPOND:** From your own perspective, what do you do the most when you feel vulnerable? 1. I put on a brave face so that no one would suspect? 2. I distract myself with something else? 3. I search out the cause and confront it? 4. I take time out and disappear? 5. I wonder what triggered it? 6. I run for help? 7. I ask my Guardian Angel to guide me?
