THIS WEEK'S GOSPEL MEDIATION ST. MARK 7:31-37



Our Lord tells us, "salvation was to come from the Jews" (John. 4:22). This was in accordance with God's plan when he took Abraham from his pagan family and surroundings, and elected him

to be the father of a Chosen People from whom God's blessing would come for all nations (Gn. 12:1-4). This was the historic beginning of "salvation" for men. It was, as yet, a vague generic promise but down through the following eighteen-century history of the Chosen People (Abraham's descendants) this blessing eventually became crystallized in the Messiah — the anointed and holy one of God. It was He who would introduce the messianic age of which the prophets so often had spoken, and it was in Him that all peoples, Jews and Gentiles, would find their true "blessing." Those who would accept Jesus and his message would later spread the good news among the Gentile nations. His Apostles, including St. Paul, and the faithful disciples having done their best for their fellow-Jews, left Palestine

and carried the great news of the incarnation- a blessing greater than any man could have imagined - to the pagan peoples of the world. It was surely from the Jews that salvation came to us Gentiles.

Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary

Mary was born to be the mother of the Savior of the world, the spiritual mother of all men, and the holiest of God's creatures. Because of her Son's infinite merits, she was conceived and born immaculate and full of grace. Through her, Queen of heaven and of earth, all grace is given to men. In Mary all human nature is exalted. We rejoice in her birthday, as the Church has done from the earliest times. This is one of the three birthdays in the Church Calendar — the Birth of Jesus (December 25), the Birth of John the Baptist (June 24) and the Birthday of Mary (September 8). All three were born without original sin, although Mary and Jesus were conceived without sin, and St. John was cleansed of original sin while in the womb at the Visitation Mary.

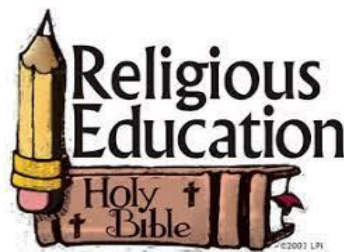

The Independent Victim Compensation Program (ICP), a program sponsored by the Diocese of San Diego to assist victim-survivors who were abused as minors by priests of this diocese, began accepting applications. The ICP is independent and not controlled by the Church. There is no time limit on when the abuse may have taken place. The program will consider all claims, regardless of how long ago the accused occurred. No attorney is necessary and there are no fees of any kind. U.S. Residency is also not required.
