Code of CONDUCT

The Saint Ann Drama Club seeks to provide students with an opportunity to participate in theatrical activities and develop camaraderie, character, and poise. Participation in the Drama Club is a privilege, not a right. As a member of the Drama Club you represent our school; and your conduct and actions in the classroom, on the stage, and in the community should not deviate from the regulations and code of conduct set by Saint Ann School. Club members must show determination, dedication, and a desire to be a productive member of the group.

CONDUCT: Any violation or deviation from the student code of conduct listed in the student handbook could be reason for removal or denial of participation in the Drama Club. It is the student's responsibility to take the initiative to read the student handbook, know what the rules are, and abide by them. We expect our performers to engage in appropriate behavior at all times. If actions are not deemed appropriate and do not coincide with this organization's guidelines, the student will be denied participation in the Drama Club. Bullying or harassment in any form will not be tolerated. If a student is gossiping, instigating turmoil, or in any way causing conflict among members in the Drama Club, their participation in the Drama Club will be suspended. Attitude is a major factor in whether or not we will allow someone to perform! If a problem arises we need to know in order to help resolve the situation.

ATTENDANCE: All rehearsal dates and times are MANDATORY, unless stated by the directors. It is possible and may be inevitable that some practices or performances will be scheduled during school vacation times. It is an expectation that each participating student will dedicate him/herself to the production.

DEDICATION: There is a level of commitment required to be part of the Drama Club. The member must have a desired level of commitment not just for themselves, but also for the ENTIRE group. If at any time a member is not doing their part as a productive member of the group, they will be suspended from the Drama Club.

Reasons for receiving a warning:

- Being consistently tardy or absent
 - Abuse of social media or texting
 - Disrespectful behavior towards fellow members or adult Drama Club staff
- *3 warnings = 1 demerit

Reasons for receiving a demerit:

- Unexcused absences
- Disrespectful behavior towards fellow club members or adult Drama Club staff

Reasons for immediate dismissal from the Drama Club:

- Out-of-school suspension
- Any High Level of the Saint Ann School Code of Conduct
- Bullying
- 4 demerits
