Good Afternoon,

Today it was determined, in consultation with the Diocese, to implement a school closure effective Monday, March 16th and extending through March 27th. This decision is based on the rapid spread of COVID-19. While this is an inconvenience for many families we are taking this action in the interest of the safety and health of our students and faculty/staff. All materials necessary for the continuation plan are being sent home with students today. Please note this may be updated or adjusted as deemed necessary.

The expectation is that all students complete 30 minutes of ILA and 30 minutes of Math daily. Science and Social Studies as well as independent reading are also to be completed. Grades 5-8 will be using a combination of hard copy and Google Classroom and Google Docs. All 5-8 assignments are expected to be completed within 2 days of being assigned.

We will reevaluate the closure timing based on information as it becomes available. Any updates will continue to be communicated through our various platforms. All activities will be cancelled beginning Monday. The school building will be closed except for administrators, specific maintenance needs and deep cleaning. This means during the closure that all evening and weekend activities are either cancelled or postponed. Please reach out to me with any questions.
