Good Afternoon -

Thank you for your feedback and responses to the survey. We appreciate your thoughts as we move forward with the reopening plan.

We continue to plan for in-person instruction. Some adjustments have been made to our day – planned bathroom breaks, class breaks, etc.

Mrs. Smith will be moving to the World Language room. This allows us to keep the 5th-8th grade contained to the second floor for all their classes. Mrs. Laccetti's room is now downstairs in the former Conference Room. Mrs. Smith's old room is the isolation room for any individuals showing symptoms of COVID-19.

Masks for students and staff have arrived. Each child will receive one mask on the first day of school. After washing the masks, parents should send the mask back to school. This will ensure they always have a mask while in attendance. Again, students have the option of bringing in their own mask and the school supplied mask being a backup.

Over the course of the next few weeks, we will be installing hand-sanitizing dispensers in all classrooms. I also have interviewed three more candidates for the nursing position. These names were forwarded to the township services provider. I am hopeful to be able to announce the new nurse within the next couple of weeks. We all understand the importance of a nurse being in school and the heightened need during the current health crisis.

I have received questions about the possibility of a hybrid option for students. We are going to be offering three options for learning:

In-person, distance, hybrid. If a student is going to be using the hybrid option we ask that the days they are in-person be kept as consistent as possible so we are able to plan properly for daily social distancing measures. For the distance learning we are currently going to be using laptop cameras, if you know of any companies willing to donate webcams please let me know. Currently they are backordered and not available.

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Good Afternoon,

I have received a few questions regarding in-person. We will be offering a traditional 5 day a week in-person instruction as well as virtual and hybrid.

This means students can attend, as previously done, in person for the full week. There is also the option to have them attend class virtually or a combination of a few days in school and virtually (hybrid).

Examples:

Traditional - child attends class at Saint Ann School daily

Virtual - child joins class via Google Meet from a location other than the Saint Ann School building daily

Hybrid - child joins class via Google Meet from a location other than the Saint Ann School building for some days and attends class in person at Saint Ann School for some days during the week
