Good Evening Saint Ann School Families -

Friday the Governor released the guidelines for school reopening. I have begun reviewing the document and reviewing the summary feel much better about where we are and how are planning has been going.

At this time, I envision school reopening with in-person instruction in a socially distanced manner. This would mean a change in our typical instruction model of student groups.

I know you have questions and at this point, everything is being planned. I can tell you is the following:

The guidance specifies that all adults are required to wear face coverings, and all students need to do so when they are not 6 feet from one another. Another option is for us to put barriers on the student desks, similar to what grocery stores have set up.

The school building will be restricted to students and staff. The reopening committee is evaluating volunteer positions (lunch duty, library, etc.)

I can say that at this time with the restrictions being put in place daily schedules, drop-off and dismissal are going to be different from in the past. Once decisions are finalized, the information will be passed along to you.

We must also prepare for remote learning to be reinstated at any time.

This Tuesday is the next meeting of the school reopening committee. At this point, I plan to send weekly updates regarding our process and progress. The state is requiring that ALL schools/districts provide families this guidance by the end of July. I am hopeful that we will be able to share this information prior to that. As information is shared if you have feedback, suggestions, questions PLEASE reach out to me so that I can consider it.
